

The Road Back Summary

- All schools are required to provide in person instruction for the 2020-21 SY
- Face coverings are required for all staff
- Social distancing of six feet or face coverings are required for students
- Transportation- social distancing or face coverings
- Cleaning and sanitizing- buildings & buses sanitized daily as well as throughout the day
- Student flow, entry, exit- monitored and screening for symptoms
- Contact tracing- done in cooperation with the local Department of Health

 Note- the NJ guidelines can change- we are planning based on the most recent information



Plans being considered around the state

- <u>A Day- B Day Schedule</u>- students would attend school every other day and learn virtually the days they are not in school using social distancing when possible and face coverings when not possible.
- <u>A/B Day Schedule</u> ½ of the students 2.5 hrs in AM and the other half 2.5 hrs in PM all students would also receive 1.5 hrs of virtual instruction per day.
- <u>4 Day Cohort Model</u>- Group A attends school for 4 days and then Group B attends the next week. The fifth day of each week is fully virtual.
- <u>AM Half days</u> for all students everyday using social distancing when possible and face coverings when not possible.

Notes:

Virtual/Live Streaming- all plans will contain a live stream/virtual component when possible Day Care- we are working with our the LHYMCA and other providers to fill the gaps if possible

Siblings would attend school on the same days.



What the school day will look like

- Transportation- buses operating at approximately 50% capacity, we will need help from parents who can drive students to and from school. Students and staff wearing face coverings.
- Screening- at home reporting utilizing a form to be disseminated daily via School Messenger- trained staff will also conduct visual screening of all staff and students prior to entry.
- Social/Emotional- we will continue to embed SEL in our daily lessons. Trained staff will be available for students throughout the day.
- Students will be required to wear face coverings for part or all of the day.
- Combination of in-person and virtual instruction including live streaming.
- Extracurricular activities on hold for now- we will revisit during the school year.
- Special Education- students individual needs (including related services) will drive their programs to the maximum extent possible.
- ESL- services will be provided during the day.
- Technology- <u>all</u> students will have access to internet and devices. If you know of anyone who does not have access to the internet please contact <u>parentportal@denville.org</u>.



Next Steps

- Reopening committee meeting July 15
 - Committee members were selected to provide a cross section of all stakeholders.
 - 36 member committee including 14 people who have children in district.
- Draft a plan
- Second committee meeting early week of July 27
- Provide Draft to parents
- Survey parents
- Finalize and Board of Education approval of the plan August 10, 2020
- Create video showing the public what a school day will look like.
