JOB GOAL: To transport pupils in a safe and efficient manner and perform all activities related to the operation of the school bus.

## PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Conducts a pre-trip safety inspection of the bus prior to every trip and completes the School Bus Condition Report.
- 2. Notifies transportation coordinator of any mechanical malfunctions and/or safety hazards.
- 3. Adheres to established routes, designated bus stops and keeps to assigned time schedule.
- 4. Transports only authorized pupils and ensures that all students have left the bus at the end of the route.
- 5. Obeys all traffic laws and observes mandatory school bus safety regulations.
- 6. Reports all accidents and pupil injuries immediately to the principal and the transportation coordinator, and school business administrator and completes required reports.

- 7. Participates in emergency evacuation drills in accordance with administrative code and board policy, and instructs passengers regarding safety regulations and other bus rules.
- 8. Performs interior bus cleaning duties daily, cleans windows as needed.
- 9. Performs related duties as assigned.
