8220 SCHOOL DAY

The Board of Education shall determine the times that school will be in session for the purpose of providing adequate time for pupils to profit from the educational program of the district. The schools of the district will be in session for pupils on those days recommended by the Superintendent and approved by the Board.

The Superintendent on the approval of the Board may temporarily alter the regular school session when such alteration is feasible and serve the best interests of the children of the district.

The Superintendent may close the schools, delay the opening of school, or dismiss school early when such alteration in the regular session is required for the protection of the health and safety of pupils and staff members and shall prepare rules for the proper and timely notification of concerned persons in the event of any emergency closing of the schools.
